Historical Background:

The New England Province took over the staffing needs of the established mission in Jamaica from the Maryland Province in 1927 and fund-raising for this mission was shared by the Province Treasurer and Fathers in various parishes and schools. When the Province began a new mission to Baghdad, Iraq in the early 1930s, fund-raising for the growing mission work required more supervision. Two new offices were created to meet these needs: Director of the Jesuit Seminary Guild and Mission Procurator. In addition to fund-raising, the duties of the Mission Procurator, and the successor offices, included acting as aide to the New England Provincial; acting as aide to the Superiors, Vice Provincials, or Provincials of mission areas assigned to the New England Province; representing the Province missions and missionaries at meetings; providing personal services to missionaries on leave, processing and shipping of supplies and equipment; and, acting as liaison between the missions and the home province.

Foreign Missions Procurators, Treasurers, Directors

The first Mission Procurator was Rev. Edward Tivnan, SJ, who served from 1931-1932. From 1932-1933, Rev. Frank Sullivan, SJ, assumed the office and Rev. William Lynch, SJ, served from 1933-1934. In 1934, the Mission Procurator also served as the Director of the Jesuit Seminary Guild and Rev. George Murphy, SJ, directed these offices until 1937. From 1937-1940, Rev. Murphy ran only the Mission Procurator office. In 1940, the two positions again merged and Rev. John Madden, SJ, was appointed to the office. In 1943, Rev. Thomas McDermott, SJ, became the Mission Procurator and in 1945, Rev. Thomas Feeney, SJ, assumed the office. In 1947, Rev. John Collins, SJ, was appointed to the office and in 1953, Rev. Francis Anderson, SJ, served. In 1958, the title of the office was changed from Mission Procurator to Mission Treasurer. In 1959, Rev. Thomas McDermott, SJ, again assumed the office and served until 1961. The title of the position changed in 1961 to Mission Director and Rev. Thomas Hussey, SJ, assumed the title. Rev. Anderson, SJ, was appointed to the position again in 1965 to 1968, when Rev. Robert F. O'Brien, SJ, served as Director of Province Missions and Rev. Anderson became Assistant Director of Services for Missions. At that time, there were also two other Assistant Directors: Rev. Vincent P. Kelliher, SJ, Assistant Director for Fund Raising and Rev. Joseph L. Ryan, SJ, Assistant Director for Planning. Rev. O'Brien functioned as the first Director for International Apostolates / Ministries, although he never held that title. In 1973, the position was split with Rev. John Banks, SJ, serving as the Director of International Apostolates, whose duties included being the Provincial representative in charge of personnel, and Rev. Thomas J. Kelly, SJ, Director of Province Mission [Services] in charge of raising funds for the overseas missions. Rev. William Raftery, SJ, became the new Director of Province Missions [Services] in 1978. In 1981, Rev. Raftery became the Director of Jesuit Missions. In 1987, the position became the Director of the Jesuit Missions Bureau and Rev. E. Corbett Walsh, SJ, was appointed. In 1988, Rev. William Russell, SJ, and Br. James P. McDavitt, SJ, became Co-Directors of the Jesuit Seminary and Mission Bureau. In 1998, Br. MacDavitt, SJ, became the Director of the Jesuit Seminary and Mission Bureau and held the position 2005.

International Apostolates / Ministries

Fr. Provincial William G. Guindon, SJ, undertook an administrative re-structuring of the Provincial's Offices at the beginning of his term as provincial (1968-1974). As part of this re-organization, a position for a Vice-Provincial for International Apostolates was planned. Fr. General decided that this Vice-Provincial was redundant and, therefore, unnecessary. The duties of the position were modified and it emerged as the Director of International Apostolates or International Ministries, depending on the year. Rev. Robert O'Brien, SJ, who officially held the title of Mission Director functioned as the Vice Provincial of International Apostolates, although he never held the title, and worked from the Provincial's Offices not the Mission Office location.

Logistics Note: Between 1946 and the early 1970s, the various Missions Offices were housed at different locations from the Provincial's Offices. All the offices were consolidated at one facility, the Harrison Avenue complex (Immaculate Conception Church and old Boston College High School) in the early 1970s.

His successor, Rev. John P. Banks, SJ, was the first to be officially appointed Director of International Apostolates in 1973. This position included being advisor / consultant to the Provincial and province staff on matters relating to missions: personnel assignments, training and spiritual renewal. Duties also include visiting missions, and meeting with personnel of other mission-sending societies for workshops, discussions, problem solving and mission spirituality. There were five main tasks areas associated with this position: 1) serving as convener, secretary, and resources person for the Province Assistants for International Ministry in North America; 2) be at the service of the Jesuit Conference Board as it required his help in matters relating to international ministry; 3) to serve the Jesuit Conference National Office in matters which had an international dimension, performing this duty under the direction of the Jesuit Conference Secretary for Ministries; 4) communicating with important US organizations and agencies involved in international ministry including attendance at national and international meetings related to international ministry; and 5) providing for Jesuits, Jesuit sponsored ministries, and the various publics each serves, information on the international ministries in which North American Jesuits are serving, together with suggestions on what could be done to help such international ministries. This new position encompassed such duties as becoming the Provincial representative in charge of international personnel and serving as liaison to the Jesuit Conference Board, reporting to the Jesuit Conference President through the Jesuit Conference Secretary to Ministries. This role also included cooperating closely with other national Jesuit offices in areas of common concern such as Pastoral and Social Ministries.

Rev. Robert O'Brien, SJ, functioned as the first Director of International Apostolates. Rev. John Banks, SJ, served as the first Director of International Apostolates and in 1974, Rev. Simon E. Smith, SJ, became the Director of International Ministries. In 1975, Rev. Joseph O'Connor, SJ, served in the position to 1980. From 1980 to 1996, Rev. Martin P. MacDonnell, SJ, functioned as the Director of International Ministries, although he held several different titles. For example, in 1989, the office changed titles to the Associate Director for International Apostolates and again in 1992 to the Provincial Assistant for the International Apostolates and Refugee Services. During most of this time, he also served in other administrative posts, such as Socius (Executive Assistant) to the Provincial. In 1997, Rev. Thomas H. Schneider, SJ, became the Province Liaison for International Ministries and in 1999, Rev. James M. Hayes, SJ, became Provincial Liaison to JIM (Jesuit International Ministries). In 2002, this position was merged with an existing one, the Assistant for International, Pastoral, and Social Ministries headed by Rev. Michael D. Linden, SJ. In 2011, Fr. Linden was also appointed the new Superior of the Jesuits in Jordan and Iraq, based in Amman, Jordan, where he continued with his service as Assistant for International Ministries for the New England Province. In 2014, when the New England and New York Provinces merged to become the USA Northeast Province, Fr. Gregory F. Muckenhaupt, S.J. was appointed Assistant to the Provincial for International Ministries in Micronesia (Yap, Caroline and Marshall Islands), Jamaica and Jordan (USA Northeast Circular Letter 2014.02, dated December 5, 2014). Fr. Linden continued to Superior in Amman.

Scope and Content:

This series contains the records of the Directors of the various Missions Offices: Jesuit Missions, Jesuit Foreign Missions, Jesuit Seminary & Mission Bureau, and International Apostolates or International Ministries (depending on the year). The collection contains correspondence with various groups and individuals as well as reports and subject files. There is little material from the 1930s until the 1950s and then the volume of records began to increase.

The Directors Records are sub-divided into two series: Curia Correspondence and Directors' Files. The Curia Correspondence consists of letters between the Mission Office and the Provincials Office and with Richard Cardinal Cushing. The Curia Correspondence covers 1956 to 1971. The Directors' Files in this series are those which were clearly identified as one person's file and are not part of a subject files series. Not all directors have files in this collection, although some files may be found under the more general subject files series, see the following table where directors without files are identified with an asterisk, "*". In other words, each director kept some of his own subject files, but generally, subject files were also kept in a common filing area. The directors' records in this series are those which were clearly identified as one person's file and are not part of a subject files series. Each Directors' Files are divided into the following subjects: Missions: Jamaica, Iraq, Brazil, Mid-East; Financial; and Other. Most are arranged chronologically. Both the terms "Curia Correspondence" and "Directors Files" are terms assigned by the archives.
