Abstract: Saint Francis Xavier College Church is a Roman Catholic, Jesuit parish located in Saint Louis, Missouri. Adjacent to the Saint Louis University campus, College Church is the third oldest parish in St. Louis. This collection contains artifacts, operational records, publications, writings, photographs and prints related to the history Saint Francis Xavier College Church. Though most material refers to the operation of College Church at its location on Grand and Lindell Avenues, a small number of records pertaining to the church at its first location on 9th and Christy are represented in this collection.

Saint Francis Xavier College Church is a Roman Catholic, Jesuit parish located in Saint Louis, Missouri. Adjacent to the Saint Louis University campus, College Church is the third oldest parish in St. Louis. In 1836, the Jesuits of Saint Louis University were granted permission by Bishop Joseph Rosati to found a parish in conjunction with their newly founded college. In addition to serving the Saint Louis University community, Saint Francis Xavier parish responded to the needs of the English and Irish populations of Saint Louis. Originally, members met as a congregation at Saint Louis University's Aloysius Chapel located on Washington Avenue. A popular parish, it became clear that the congregation was outgrowing the space that the University provided, and the cornerstone of the first Saint Francis Xavier Church was laid at Ninth Street and Christy Avenue on April 12, 1840.

As the city of Saint Louis and Saint Louis University moved west, the congregation of Saint Francis Xavier College Church moved as well. In 1867, the Jesuits at Saint Louis University purchased land in Lindell's Grove at Grand Avenue as a new site for their college. It was not until 1879, however, that Archbishop Peter Kenrick gave the Jesuits permission to build a new church to serve the University community at their new location. In 1883, Thomas Walsh was chosen as the architect for the new church, and construction began at Lindell and Grand Avenues in 1884. The lower section of College Church opened for worship later that year while construction continued on the upper church.

Chicago architect Henry W. Switzer took over the upper church building project after Walsh's death in 1890. Changing Walsh's original design, Switzer made the upper church a transitional English Gothic quality based both on the southwest tower of the Chartres Cathedral and the spire of the Cathedral of Saint Colman in Cobh, Ireland. The upper church, except for the spire, was completed in 1897 and dedicated in 1898. The spire was completed in 1915.

Scope and content note

The Saint Francis Xavier College Church collection contains artifacts, operational records, publications, writings, photographs and prints related to the history Saint Francis Xavier College Church established in 1840. Though most material refers to the operation of College Church at its location on Grand and Lindell Avenues, a small number of records pertaining to the church at its first location on 9th and Christy are represented in this collection. Some records in this collection may also contain information about Saint Louis University due to the church's close relationship with the university.

The artifacts series contains liturgical objects, plaques, certificates, Sunday school materials, and ephemera from Saint Francis Xavier College Church parish celebrations. Operational records consist of documents created and kept as part of daily operations at Saint Francis Xavier College Church. This series contains correspondence, financial and property records, liturgical materials, as well as sodality and parish organization records created between 1843 and 2005. The publications and writings series consists of works about Saint Francis Xavier College Church, including church bulletins, histories, and material produced for anniversary celebrations. The photographs and prints series primarily contains photographs, negatives, slides, and drawings of Saint Francis Xavier College Church and its parish community. Prints and other works of art collected by or gifted to College Church are also included in this series.

Scope and content note:

The artifacts series contains ephemera from Saint Francis Xavier College Church parish celebrations, liturgical objects, plaques and certificates, and Sunday school materials. Of particular note in this series is a cloth applied to the remains of St. Francis Xavier when the saint's body was exposed for veneration in 1931.

Series 2. Operational records, 1843-2005

Scope and content note:

This series contains records created and kept as part of daily operations at Saint Francis Xavier College Church. These records consist of correspondence, financial and property records, liturgical materials, as well as sodality and parish organization records created between 1843 and 2005. Though most material refers to the operation of the current St. Francis Xavier College Church, located on Grand and Lindell Avenues, records pertaining to the church at its first location on 9th and Christy are described as "Old Saint Francis Xavier" materials. Some records may contain information about St. Louis University due to the church's close relationship with the university.

Arrangement note:

This series is arranged in four subseries: correspondence, financial and property records, liturgical materials, and sodality and parish organization records. All subseries are intellectually arranged chronologically. Materials have been physically left in their original order.

Subseries 2.1. Correspondence, 1845-1985

Scope and content note:

This subseries contains correspondence related to the daily operations of Saint Francis Xavier College Church. Correspondence includes general correspondence, pastor's correspondence, financial and consultor's correspondence, as well as letters sent as part of Provincial visitations to the church. Though most material refers to the operation of the current St. Francis Xavier College Church, located on Grand and Lindell Avenues, records pertaining to the church at its first location on 9th and Christy are described as "Old Saint Francis Xavier" materials.

Scope and content note:

Property records include information about the church building, especially the 1991 renovation.

This subseries contains material related to the Sodalities and other parish organizations in which the lay members of Saint Francis Xavier College Church participated from 1843 to 1961. Groups represented in this subseries include the Young Men's Sodality, the League of the Sacred Heart, the Holy Name Society, the Apostleship for Prayer, and the Circle. Records related to these groups include, register and roll books, meeting minutes, as well as rule and prayer books. Of particular note in the subseries are the deeds and maps related to the Young Men's Sodality cemetery lots purchased in 1875.
