Scope and Contents

This collection is comprised of legal records, correspondence, house diaries (some in Latin), church community materials, financial records, and local publications. The bulk of the material dates between the 1920s and the 1960s.

Historical Note¹

Akulurak is a Yup'ik word meaning "in-between place," and thus was a fitting name for the community the Jesuits joined in 1903, situated on an island in the Andreafsky River near its confluence with the Yukon. There, the Jesuits built a school to care for children orphaned by an epidemic of the flu in 1900-1901.

By the late 1940s, the island's slough had silted in, making it difficult to continue living there. The community relocated to the current site of St. Mary's, Alaska, using building materials from an abandoned Gold Rush-era hotel as supplies, and incorporated in 1957.

The Catholic church in St. Mary's closed in 1987.

Please note that items in this collection do use "Eskimo," an outdated and offensive term for the Inuit people of the Arctic region. In finding aids for previously processed collections, JARC maintains the word choices used by materials' creators to contextualize those materials but recognizes that decision can still cause hurt to the communities affected by that language. In all modern documentation (newly processed collections, exhibits, communications, et cetera), JARC makes every effort to use the language preferred by the communities being described.
